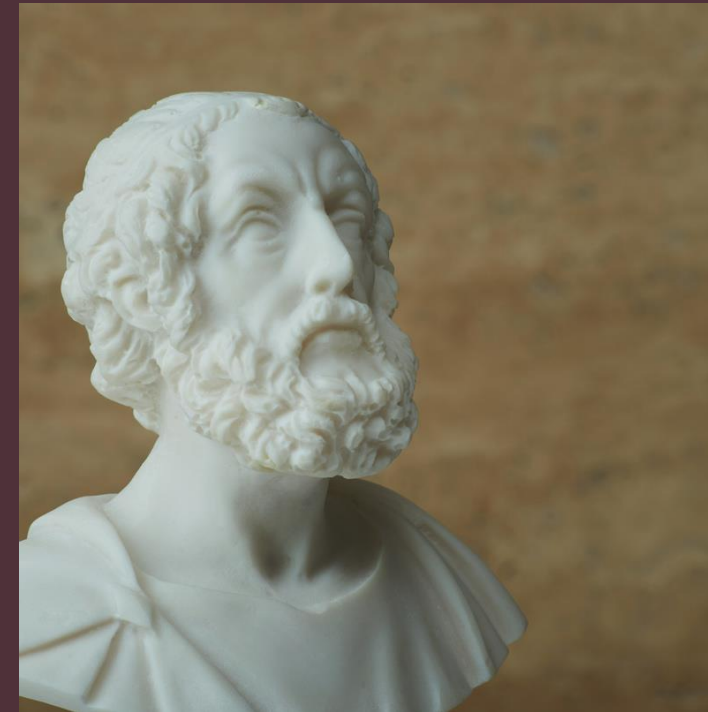

No One but Jesus (Exd 24.15–16; 40.35; 1 Kgs 8.10–11; Mark 1.11)



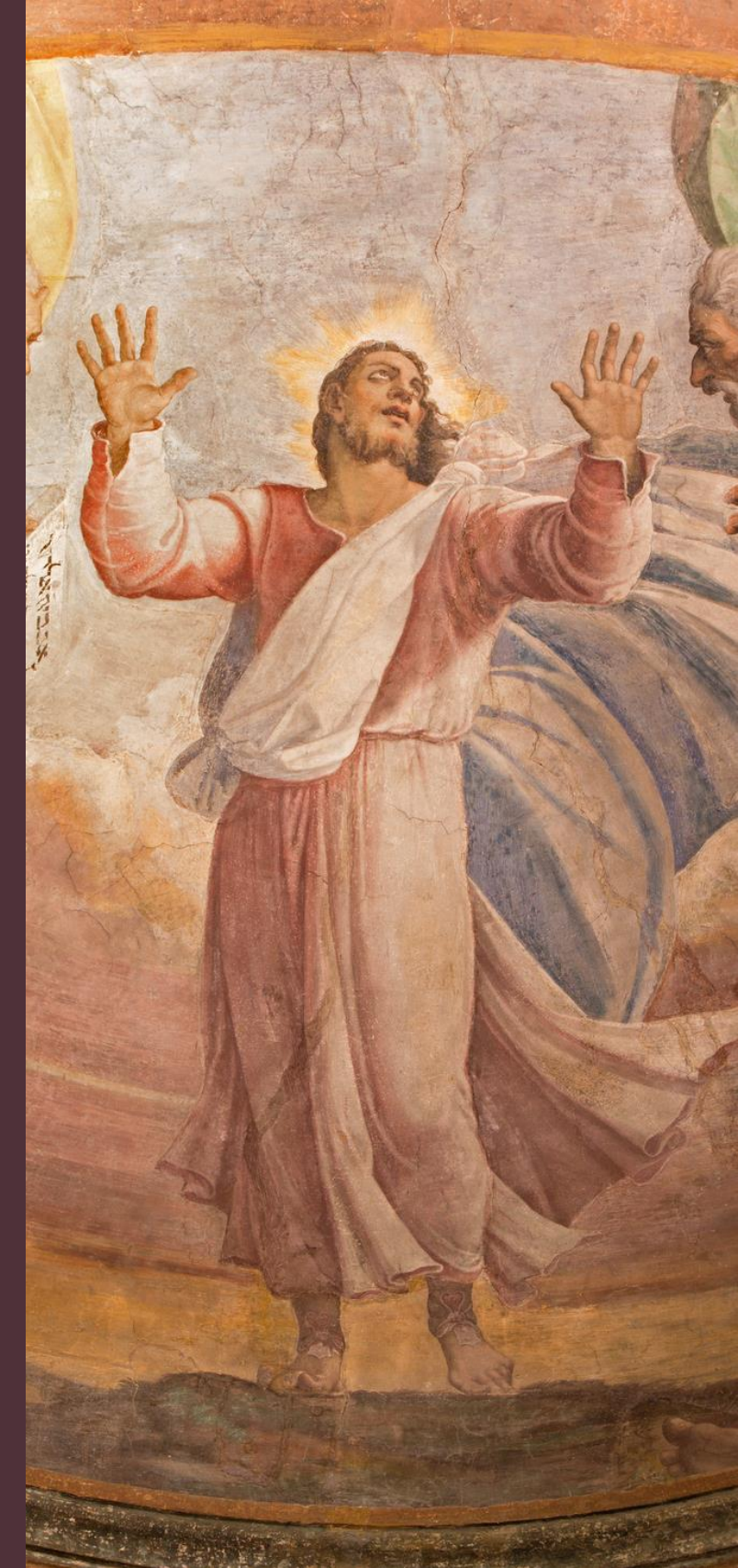
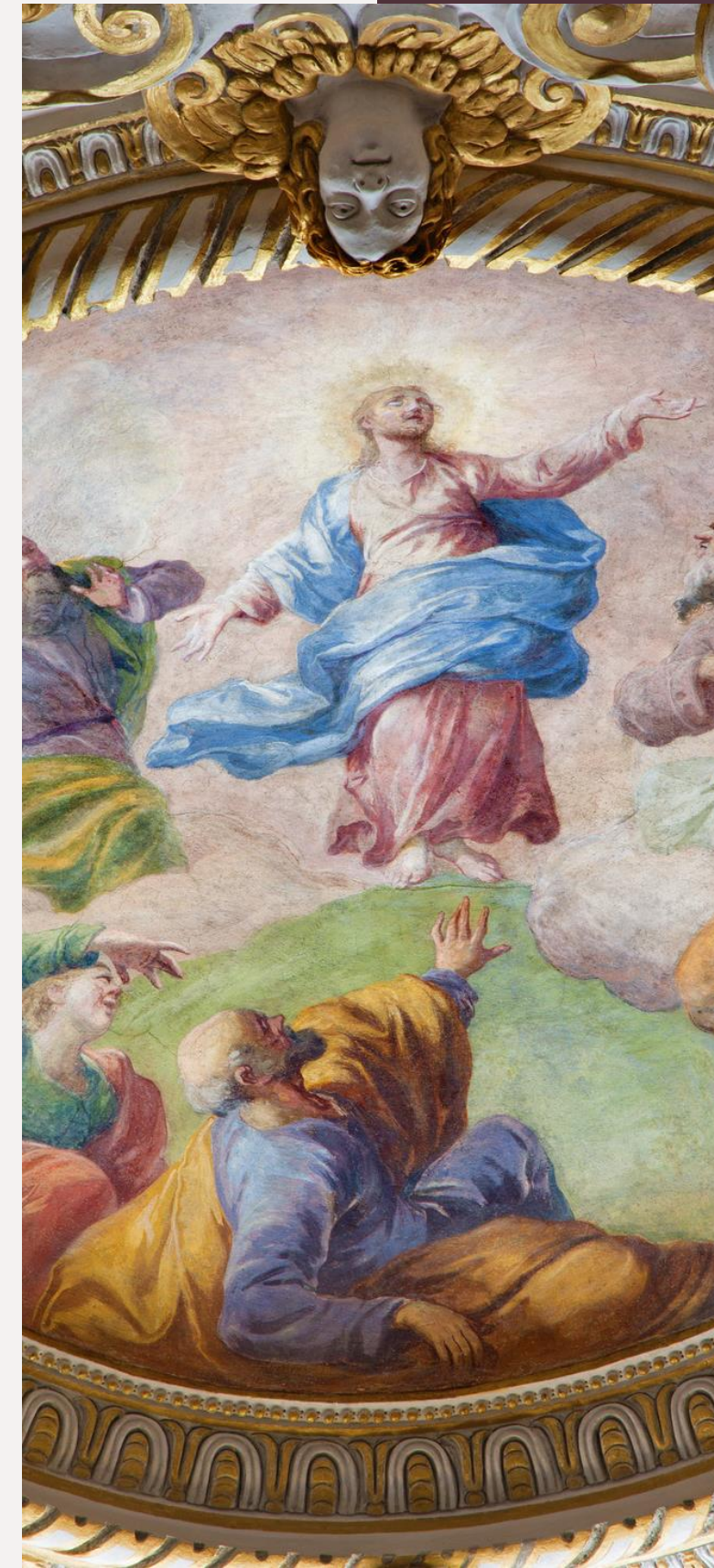
Must the Messiah Suffer? (9.9–13)
