



Moses wrote down all the words of the LORD. He rose early the next morning and set up an altar and twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel at the base of the mountain. Then he sent out young Israelite men, and they offered burnt offerings and sacrificed bulls as fellowship offerings to the LORD. Moses took half the blood and set it in basins; the other half of the blood he splattered on the altar. He then took the book of the covenant and read it aloud to the people. They responded, "We will do and obey all that the LORD has commanded" (Exd 24.3–7).





WITCHCRAFT Seeking power, not from God

BESTIALITY Connected to idolatrous practice

SACRIFICE A capital punishment

FORBIDDEN CULTIC PRACTICES (22.18–20)

PROTECTING THE VULNERABLE (22.21–27)



A protected class because of culture (cf. Gen 19; Jgs 19)



Not allowed to charge interest (cf. ANE rates)

WIDOWS/ORPHANS

A protected class because of culture (e.g., 1 Kgs 17; 1 Tim 5; Mark 7)

Pledges are part of their needs, so we must protect them 9. Book of the Covenant


