


The Context

- The Feast of Booths (Lev. 23:33-43)
 - Last of the fall festivals end of agricultural year
 - Primary purpose: Celebrate God's care for Israel
 - Remembrance of wilderness journey
 - Celebration feast after gathering the crops
 - Looking forward to Messiah
 - Other ceremonial things added later
 - Carrying water from pool of Siloam to pour into the basin near the altar in the Temple




Jesus' Brothers (7:3-10)


- "Show yourself to the world"
 - Perfect opportunity given the nature of the Feast
 - All Jewish males required to be in Jerusalem
- > The world hates me because I testify that its deeds are evil
 - > I John 3:13 "Do not be surprised if the world hates you"
 - ➤ II Tim. 3:12 "Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted."
- Did Jesus lie to his brothers?
 - "You go up to this feast. I am not yet going up to this feast, for My time has not yet fully come." (NKJV)
 - Older manuscripts include "yet."


Jesus' Teachings (7:14-39)


- Evidence of true belief
 - Willing to do God's will
 - Knows that Jesus words are from God
 - Does not seek his own glory, but God's
- "Judge with righteous judgment"
 - Obeying God (circumcision) vs. Obeying God (healing)
 - Not on the basis of appearance
 - Not on the basis of human standards
- "You both know Me and where I am from"
- "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink."
 - Last day of the Feast, pouring of water on the altar

Jesus' Teachings (7:14-39)

- Verse 37-39 "Come to Me and drink"
 - ➤ He who believes in me from <u>his</u> innermost being will flow rivers of living water
 - > Those who believed were to receive the Spirit
 - Cf. Acts 2:38 What could this be?
 - Consider the following
 - God will pour forth His spirit (2:17-21)
 - Jesus received promise of the Spirit (2:33-36)
 - Promise of HS = Kingdom (Prophecies in OT)
 - The gift of Holy Spirit (access to the kingdom) being offered in Acts 2:38 (10:45; Gal 3:14)

The Adulterous Woman

- Caught in adultery, no question of her guilt
- Entire situation problematic and hypocritical
 - Adulterer and Adulteress Lev 20:10; Deut. 22:22
 - Trying to trap Jesus
- "Let him who is without sin cast the first stone"
 - Not teaching perfection before correction (Matt. 18)
 - Witness casts first stone (Deut. 17:17)
 - > They didn't care about her soul or about justice
- "Neither do I condemn. Go and sin no more"
 - Jesus didn't excuse the sin
 - Also did not condemn her (John 3)

Jesus' Teachings

- "You will seek me, and will die in your sins"
- "Unless you believe that I am He, you will die in your sin"
- "You will know the truth and the truth shall make you free"
- God is not your Father (42-47)
 - You do not love Jesus (42)
 - > You do not understand the will of God (43)
 - > You do not do what the Father desires (44)
 - > You do not believe the truth (45-46)
 - > You do not listen to His words (47)
